

Diesel Mechanic

Job Overview:

The primary function of the Diesel Mechanic is to: diagnose, adjust, repair, or overhaul trucks, equipment, and all types of diesel engines. This is in a small shop environment. Compliance with all DOT, Company and Safety Policies, procedures and practices are required at all times.

Essential Job Functions:

- Use hand tools such as screwdrivers, pliers, wrenches, pressure gauges, and precision instruments, as well as power tools such as pneumatic wrenches, lathes, welding equipment, jacks and hoists.
- Inspect brake systems, steering mechanisms, wheel bearings, and other parts to ensure proper operating condition.
- Perform routine maintenance such as changing oil, checking batteries, and lubricating equipment and machinery.
- Adjust air brakes, align wheels, tighten bolts and screws, and reassemble equipment.
- Raise trucks, equipment, and heavy parts using hydraulic jacks and hoists.
- Test drive trucks and equipment to diagnose malfunctions or to ensure that they are in proper working order.
- Inspect, test and listen to defective equipment to diagnose malfunctions, using test instruments such as handheld computers, motor analyzers, chassis charts, and pressure gauges.
- Examine and adjust protective guards, loose bolts, and specify safety devices.
- Inspect and verify dimension and clearances of parts to ensure conformance to factory specifications.
- Specialize in repairing and maintaining parts of engine, such as fuel injection systems.
- Attach test instruments to equipment, and read dials and gauges to diagnose malfunctions.
- Rewire ignition systems, lights, and instrument panels.
- Recondition and replace parts, pistons, bearings, gears, and valves.
- Repair and adjust seats, doors, and windows, and install repair accessories.
- Inspect, repair, and maintain automotive equipment and machinery such as pumps and compressors.
- Disassemble and overhaul internal combustion engines, pumps, generators, transmissions, clutches, and differential units.
- Rebuild gas or diesel engines.
- Align front ends and suspension systems.
- Perform occasional road side calls.
- Ability to push 96 pounds, pull 130 pounds, carry 100 pounds.
- Ability to crawl under trucks and equipment, which may include confined spaces.
- Communicate with drivers and dispatch in regards to any vehicle issues.
- Performs routine housekeeping in accordance with established shop standards.
- Responsible for completing all work order documentation. (Must ensure all parts and labor are recorded)
- Demonstrate professionalism; be courteous and friendly to customers at all times.
- Regular and reliable attendance. Good interpersonal skills.
- Follow company quality, safety and environmental guidelines as well as employee handbook policies.
- Other duties as assigned by management and operate in a constant state of alertness and safe manner.
